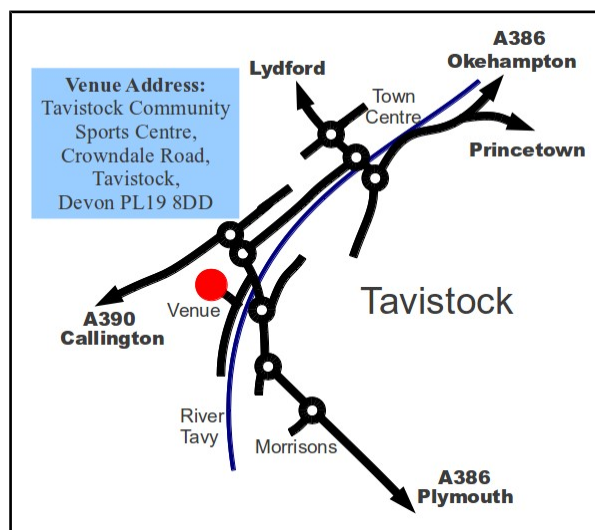
How to find the Venue:

Travelling from Plymouth . . .

Follow signs to Tavistock (A386). When you arrive at Tavistock go straight over at the "Morrisons" roundabout; straight over at next mini roundabout then first left - signposted to Crowndale Recycling Centre. Tavistock Community Sports Centre is the second entrance on the right.

Travelling from Okehampton . . .

Follow signs for Tavistock (A386). When you get to Tavistock, follow the signs for Plymouth; when you arrive at the Sir Francis Drake statue, which is a roundabout, turn left and then take the next right, signposted Crowndale Recycling Centre. Tavistock Community Sports Centre is the second entrance on the right.
